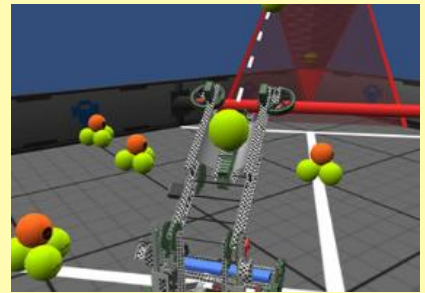
Student Support Centre
