Dual Track Programs

William G. Miller is a dual track school offering both regular English (Full day JK - 8) and Early French Immersion (Full day JK - 8) programs. The only entry point for Early French Immersion is at the Junior Kindergarten level. Students come from: Centennial Rd PS, Charlottetown PS, Highland Creek PS, Joseph Brant, Poplar Road, West Hill PS, West Rouge PS, Wm G. Davis PS and Wm G. Miller.

William G. Miller is a JK to Grade 8 school located at the end of Bennett Road, south of Lawrence Avenue East, between Morningside Ave. and Port Union Rd; on 5.5 acres of land. The school opened in 1959 and was named in honour of the late William G. Miller, who served as a trustee in south Scarborough.

Our school serves approximately 450 students; 40% are enrolled in our regular program and 60% are enrolled in our French Immersion program.

Other facts

We offer a safe learning environment, defined by our Safe School Policy and supported by a Code of Conduct and Safety Patrollers. We have an experienced, caring and committed staff. We offer a balanced, challenging and comprehensive program. An after-school child care program offered by the YMCA, (K and school age) whose philosophy supports and extends that of the school is housed in the building.

New Technology

We are always trying to update our technology to keep up with changing times. Students in Grade 5 are now provided with the own 1:1 devices.
